ASA 102 USMLE Directed Study 6 cr

Assessment and development of individualized plan with concentration on areas of difficulty. Assessment of study and test taking skills used on previous USMLE to determine weak areas. Emphasis on working through practice questions and practice tests on the computer for every course. And if determined to be necessary, students will take a review course in preparation for the examination. This course is elective for students who are taking the USMLE for the second time. Study will be directly supervised by the Assistant Dean for Special Programs and Student Affairs.

ASA 311 M3 Academic Success 4 cr

Provide M3 students with additional time and support services for success on USMLE licensure exams.
